## Question: Is there Adhaan for the Eid Prayer? Answer: NO

The Eid prayer is not preceded with Adhaan or Iqaamah. Ibn `Abbaas and Jaabir said: "Adhaan was never given (for the Eid prayer) on the day of Fitr, nor the day of Adha." (al-Bukhari)

## Question: Is fasting during the month of Ramadan Fard or Sunnah? Answer: Fard

"The month of Ramadan in which was revealed the Qur'an, a guidance for mankind and clear proofs for the guidance and the Criterion (between right and wrong). So whoever of you sights (the crescent on the first night of) the month (of Ramadan), he must fast that month. (Surah al-Baqarah, verse 185)
