Question: What time of the day is the Eid al-Fitr prayer? Answer: Anytime between sunrise and noon, but the earlier part of the day is recommended for Eid al-Fitr.

Abu Bakr (radiyallaahu `anhu) said:

"The time of the two Eid prayers is after the sun has reached the height of a spear, and until noon. However, it is best to pray al-Adh at the earliest time, to enable the people to slaughter their sacrifices; and is recommended to delay al-Fitr prayer, to enable the people to give out their Sadagah (zakat ul-Fitr)." (Muslim)

Question: Why is Laylatul Qadr so important? Answer: It is when the Qur'an was first reveled and it is worth a thousand months.

"And what will explain to you what the Night of Power is? The Night of Power is better than a thousand months." (Al-Our`an 97:2-3)

"We have indeed revealed it, (Al-Qur'an) in the Night of Power." (Al-Qur'an 97:1)

Question: What do Muslims do during the month of Ramadan? **Answer: Fast**

'O you who believe, the fast is prescribed to you as it was prescribed for those before you - perhaps you will be God-fearing.' (al-Bagarah, Verse 183)

Allah (swt) in the Qur'an:

O believer, fasting is decreed for you as it was decreed for those before you, so that $_{28}$ you may (learn to) restrain yourselves. [2:183]
